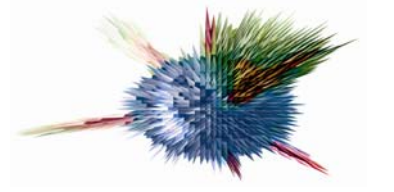

Just a reminder that if you require any help or information, please contact Alyson. You will see a vast improvement in terms of information and mailshots.

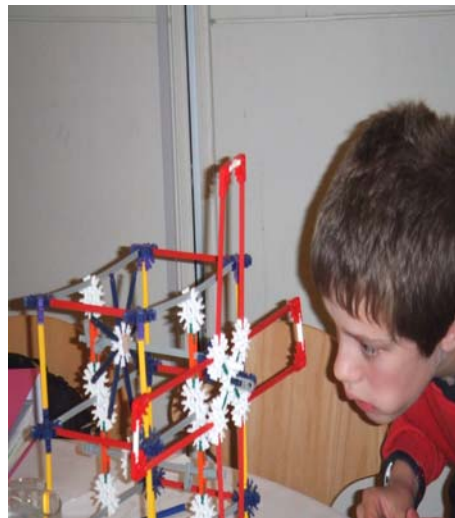
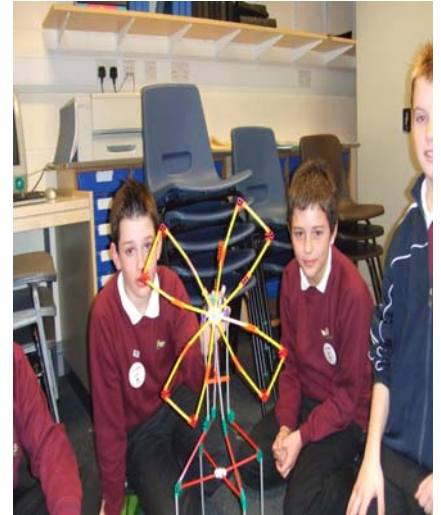
